Start off the year going back to nature with the Wild Equity Institute this Saturday at the Golden Gate National Parks Endangered Species Big Year Bike Ride & Kick-off Celebration. The day begins with a [morning bike ride](#) [1] that will explore some of the endangered flora and fauna in the city, including [Presidio Manzanita](#) [2] and and the [Southern Sea Otter](#) [3]. Co-sponsored by the SF Bicycle Coalition, the ride departs at 9:30am from Bazaar Cafe (21st Ave. & California) and ends at the Wild Equity Institute's [kick-off celebration at Sports Basement Presidio](#) [4]. If you're not into riding but want to support Wild Equity, head straight to Sports Basement at 1 for free drinks and snacks from Arizmendi and 10% off of Sports Basement merchandise (10% of the purchases will go to Wild Equity). After snacks and some shopping, the celebration will move to Crissy Field to search for the Western Snowy Plover.
